Ffigyrau Covid-19

Mae Iechyd Cyhoeddus Cymru wedi cyhoeddi bod saith achos newydd o'r coronafeirws wedi'u cadarnhau yng Nghymru, gan ddod â chyfanswm yr achosion i 15,900 a dim un achos newydd ym Mhowys. Cyfanswm yr achosion yn y sir yw 302, er mae'r ffigur hwnn'n debygol o fod yn llawer uwch.

Yn ôl ffigurau a gyhoeddwyd gan y Swyddfa Ystadegau Gwladol ar nifer y rhai fu farw ym Mhowys o ganlyniad i'r COVID-19 neu'n rhannol ar 26 Mehefin oedd 92 – 46 mewn cartrefi gofal, 37 mewn ysbytaï a naw gartref – dim cynnydd ar y ffigurau blaenorol. Nid oedd unrhyw achosion positif wedi'u dynodi gan Dîm Orlhain Cysylltiadau Powys ddoe.

Covid-19 figures

Public Health Wales has reported a further seven new confirmed cases of coronavirus in Wales, bringing the total number of cases to 15,900, with no new cases in Powys, the total for the county stands at 302 cases although the figure is likely to be much higher.

Figures issued by the Office of National Statistics (ONS) on the number of deaths in Powys attributed, either wholly or in part to COVID-19, as at June 26 was 92 – 46 in care homes, 37 in hospital and nine at home – no increase on previous figure.

There were no positive cases identified for the Powys Contact Tracing team yesterday.
