Yn ddiweddar, mae Trafnidiaeth Cymru wedi mynegi diddordeb i Gronfa Dreftadaeth y Loteri Genedlaethol ar gyfer eu cynllun ariannu coetiroedd cymunedol, ac mae wedi cael derbyniad da iawn.

Rydym yn awyddus i wneud cais am gyllid cyn diwedd y flwyddyn. **Er mwyn dyfarnu'r cyllid, mae angen i ni ddod o hyd i grwpiau cymunedol a fydd yn ein helpu i nodi ble y gallwn ddarparu plannu a gwella coed, a'n helpu i'w darparu.** Gall gwelliannau gynnwys unrhyw beth o uwchraddio llwybrau troed a llwybrau natur.

Mae gofynion y cyllid yn cynnwys:

- Rhaid i'r prosiect a ddewisir fod yn hygyrch i'r cyhoedd a chynnwys y gymuned.
- Nid oes cyfyngiadau ar faint na ffurfweddiad ardaloedd o goed sydd i'w plannu. Gallai cyfleoedd gynnwys planhigfeydd newydd (fel coed stryd neu goridor eang), cyflwyno perllannau i safleoedd cymunedol neu wella coetiroedd sy'n bodoli eisoes a chyflwyno llwybrau troed.
- Mae angen cynllun rheoli coetiroedd ond ni fydd y grant yn cynnwys gwaith cynnal a chadw ar ôl yr ail flwyddyn.

Good morning,

Transport for Wales have recently put in an expression of interest to the National Lottery Heritage Fund for their community woodlands funding scheme, and it's been really well received.

We're keen to put in an application by the end of the year, and in order to have the funding awarded **we need to find community partners that will help us identify where we can deliver tree planting and enhancements, and help us to deliver them.** Enhancements can include anything from footpath upgrades, thinning and nature trails.

Requirements of the funding include:

- It must be accessible to the public and involve the community.
- There are no limits to the size or configuration of areas of trees to be planted. Opportunities could include new plantings (such as street trees or a broad corridor), introducing orchards to community sites or improving an existing woodlands and introducing footpaths.
- A woodland management plan is required but the grant will not cover maintenance after the second year.
